ple moved in, along with new creative forces. One gallery after the other pops up and enriches the ambience.



Kabine

One of these new exceptional galleries on Islands Brygge is 'Kabine', which opened in July 2004 and still is in the process of establishing itself. It added another new concept to the area - a multifunctional art platform, a combination of gallery and show room, clothing and jewellery boutique, creative studio and drawing office for architects and designers. Behind Kabine stand architect Michala Eken and multi-artist Rie Hougaard. At the moment the legendary Nørrebro drawing office "Pinligt Selskab" exhibits "I LOVE SWEDEN!" with graphics, illustrations and watercolour paintings until February 6th. Kabine will be a show place for different exhibitions throughout the whole of spring, among others with the room installation 'Bright' (12.2.05-27.2.05) by the architects Mikkel Marker Stubgaard and Fanny Stenberg.

Kirkhoff

Kirkhoff is a fantastic and spacious gallery for international contemporary art. The gallery represents emerging, cutting-edge young artists who work with a large variety of media, e.g. painting, sculpture, video, performance and installation. At the moment Gitte Schäfer's first solo exhibition 'The Raven Is Dead' is presented here. Characteristic of Schäfer's production is a re-contextualization of works. She incorporates and connects objects from flea markets, watercolours from anonymous artists, details from famous artists' works, plants from nature; she creates abstract paintings with the round edges of a beer mat, she deconstructs furniture and puts them together in new forms. Definitely an exhibition that is worth seeing. Take a look into their reading room, which functions as flexible space for different events and has a very special design.

Workshop Copenhagen

Workshop Copenhagen is a living laboratory, a project boutique and a studio in one, where 11 girls educated as architects, designers and artisans are engaged. There are three light rooms, one of them used as boutique and show room, while the other two function as workshop for the young creative owners. In the smart disposed shelves you find things like beautiful simple ashtrays made of steel, fine and fragile ceramic bowls, jewellery, brooches and hand-knitted scarves, but also paintings and lamps. Everything you see there is made at this place itself, and if you wish to have one of the extraordinary items as custom model or colour, just ask and it will be done. Workshop Copenhagen is perfect to find unique gifts or whatever you could think of for yourself.

Galleri Nicolai Wallner is another contemporary art gallery on Islands Brygge, which exhibits innovative Scandinavian and international art. Since 1993 it has been one of the leading young galleries on the contemporary art scene. The gallery works with a diverse group of artists, all of whom work in different media. The gallery deals in a distinctive combination of photography, video, installation, painting, drawing, sculpture, etc. Their next exhibition 'Baby Shower' is opening this Friday 4th of February, which you shouldn't miss if you're an art freak. Participating artists are among others Michael Elmgreen & Ingar Dragset, David Shrigley, Joachim Koester, Jonathan Monk, Yoshitomo Nara, Ken Kagami, Mari Eastman and Peter Land.
